Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (BMPO) Let's Go Biking Virtual Challenge Official Rules

Please read these Official Rules before participating in the Challenge. By participating in the Challenge, you agree to be bound by these Official Rules and represent that you satisfy all of the eligibility requirements below.

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS CHALLENGE. (a) TWITTER, INSTAGRAM OR FACEBOOK ACCOUNT (is) REQUIRED. THE CHALLENGE IS NOT SPONSORED, ENDORSED OR ADMINISTERED BY, OR ASSOCIATED WITH, TWITTER, INC., INSTAGRAM INC., FACEBOOK INC. OR ANY OTHERS.

Description: The Challenge is a county-wide event and open to all group of ages. Participants are encouraged to pedal on throughout the month of March and qualify for prizes! Riders can complete a bike ride route of their preference anywhere in Broward County, Florida. To qualify for selection, a participant must register to the Challenge and select one of the following categories to submit the required information to the BMPO.

Category One: Total Miles Ridden

In this category participants need the use of a fitness tracking app to record the number of miles ridden from March 1 to March 31, 2021. Participants must send the monthly summary report to garcias@browardmpo.org by Thursday, April 1, 2021, 11:59 p.m.

- II. Second Place.
- **III.** Third Place.

Category Two: Social Media

In this category participants must upload a picture of their ride onto Facebook®, Instagram® and Twitter® with the following hashtag #LetsGoBiking and tag @speakupbroward to be entered to a raffle. The winners for this category will be randomly selected. Participants must upload the picture by Wednesday, March 31, 2021.

The participants that qualify for entry with the parameters stated above will have their email address, Instagram, Facebook or Twitter ID (name) placed in a random selection generator for example see https://wheelofnames.com/. Each Prize winner will be the name that is selected, the name will then be removed from the running of the next Prize, and so on and so forth until all Prizes are awarded. Limit one (1) Prize per participant for the entire Challenge.

- 1. Eligibility. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY to enter or win. The Challenge is open to adults 18 years of age or older and who are residents of Broward County. This Challenge is void where prohibited or restricted by law and subject to Federal, State and local laws.
