




Broward Complete Streets Implementation Survey Results

In July of 2012, the Broward MPO unanimously endorsed the Broward Complete Streets Guidelines with the intent of providing municipalities standards to implement safer, healthier streets. A year later, we wanted to check in with the 32 jurisdictions within Broward County and receive their thoughts on Complete Streets throughout their community. A total of 19 jurisdictions submitted their answers with additional responses submitted from several municipalities compiling a total of 32 surveys.

Jurisdictions who shared their input were Broward County, Coconut Creek, Cooper City, Coral Springs, Deerfield Beach, Fort Lauderdale, Hollywood, Lauderdale by the Sea, Margate, Miramar, North Lauderdale, Oakland Park, Parkland, Pompano Beach, Pembroke Park, Plantation, Sea Ranch Lakes, Southwest Ranches, and City of Sunrise.




