
FREIGHT COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED TO SUPPORT BROWARD MPO FREIGHT EFFORTS

The Broward MPO has established a Freight Transportation Advisory

Committee (FTAC) to deal with the growing movement of freight in Southeast Florida and in Broward County. The FTAC is comprised of members that are directly involved in the movement and distribution of freight and goods, and includes representatives from the Florida East Coast (FEC) Railway, the Port



Everglades Association, Florida 595 Truck Stop, the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, and more. The MPO established the FTAC to provide a forum where members in the freight community can provide input into the freight planning process, network with industry leaders, and gain insight into the MPO decision process. MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR

January was a busy month for the Broward MPO. First came the second Annual MPO Board Member Strategic Planning Retreat. The purpose was to test how effective our 2016 Strategic Business Plan was and to learn and grow in creating a new plan for 2017. Throughout 2016, MPO Board members met with staff to develop strategic plans that would help us accomplish our challenging objectives. This was done successfully.

It had become apparent that to take on new challenges, it would be necessary to examine our organizational structure, and this was done with the help of an exceptional business organization strategist. We had several meetings with him, and that plan will be rolled out in the next 60 days.

Also in January, the MPO hosted the <u>Fourth Annual Safe Streets Summit</u>, held this year at the Sunrise Civic Center in Sunrise. This year's Safe Streets Summit brought together over 250 transportation planners, elected officials, and community advocates to discuss ways to make Broward's streets safer and more accessible for all users of the road. This was the first year the event was held as a partnership between the Broward, Miami-Dade, and Palm Beach MPOs, and highlights the ways that the three South Florida MPOs are working together to take steps to implement Complete Streets in our communities. There is no one-size-fits all approach; each community is unique and solutions have to be tailored to those situations. The 2018 Safe Streets Summit will be held in Palm Beach County.

Within the next 60 days, the MPO should be moving into its new office space, providing for additional meeting rooms and a larger Board Room to accommodate a growing organization. The building is the same, but we are moving to the sixth floor. We are hoping our July Board Meeting will be in that space.

In celebration of March is Florida Bike Month, the 2017 Let's Go Biking! event will be held on Sunday, March 19th at 9:00 a.m. at Community Park in Pompano Beach. Join us for an adult and children's bike ride, bicycle safety activities, bike related giveaways, music, free food, and more. This is the first Let's Go Biking! event that will feature an on-street ride, which will go on NE 14th Avenue and down Riverside Drive to the Pompano Beach Fire Station. The event is a partnership between the Broward MPO and the City of Pompano Beach. MPO Helps High School Students 'Think Like a Planner' with Innovative Workshops

The MPO is committed to mentoring the future generation and raising awareness about the importance of transportation. As part of its commitment to outreach and education, the Broward MPO has hosted several "Think Like a Planner" workshops with



students from Deerfield Beach High School to teach planning principals and have students learn more about careers in transportation, engineering, and related fields. At the workshops, students come to the Broward MPO office and walk the area nearby, which encompasses the Cypress Creek Mobility Hub. Students brainstorm ways to make the area safer and more accessible for all modes of transportation, especially those who walk, bike, and take transit. After coming up with ideas, the students present their findings to a panel made up of Broward MPO Board Members and local transportation professionals. These innovative and dynamic sessions expose the Broward MPO's mission to a new group of community members. More workshops are planned with students from South Broward and Piper High Schools in the coming months.
