


### **KEY QUESTIONS TO BE ANSWERED**



### **EQUITY AREAS**

- Calculates composite "equity" score based on selected demographic indicators
- Uses US Census data by Block Group
- Core Indicators:
  - Racial Minority
  - Ethnic Minority
  - Youth (10-17 years)
  - Older Adults (65+ years)
  - Population below Poverty
  - Limited English Proficient Population (LEP)
  - Population with a Disability







**Total Revenues = \$8.3 billion** 

\$6.5 billion

- State/Federal Roadway Funding (78%)
- Transit Operating/Capital (15%)
- MPO Attributable Funds (7%)


