To collaboratively plan, prioritize and fund the delivery of diverse transportation options.







#### **NEEDS ASSESSMENT – SURTAX**


- County Transportation Surtax passed Nov. 6<sup>th</sup>
- \$15.6B in revenues over 30 years
- Surtax includes allocation for municipal transportation projects
- Broward MPO responsible for prioritizing municipal projects
- 26 miles of light rail alignment to be determined by Broward MPO working with partners






## How will the **Broward MPO** Incorporate the **County Surtax?**

The approach to developing the Commitment 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan currently focuses on assigning cost-feasible projects into one of six funding programs -Highway, Transportation Systems Management & Operations (TSM&O) and Safety, Transit, Complete Streets and Other Localized Initiatives Program (CSLIP), Mobility Hubs, and Complete Streets Master Plan (CSMP). With the successful vote for the County Surtax we will add a new funding program to prioritize the 10% County Surtax for Local Projects.







#### **NEXT STEPS**

- Continue work on Scenario Planning
- Coordinate with partners on Transit Systems Plan
- Finalize draft list of projects (transmit to FTAC for review)
- Coordination with the Regional Transportation Plan
