Introductions

The Complete Streets Master Plan Project Advisory Committee (PAC) met on Wednesday, May 22, 2017, for its kickoff meeting to discuss an overview of the Complete Streets Master Plan and the next steps to be taken.

Interest in Complete Streets?

The following is a sampling of PAC members' comments related to interest in Complete Streets.

- Ensure that our roads include opportunities for all modes of transportation.
- Enhance safe mobility on our roadways.
- Incorporate transit elements such as bus lanes into a complete streets design.
- Leverage existing assets to connect people further.
- Help identify projects for the master plan that can be incorporated into work programs.

Presentation

- The first several phases of Broward Mobility Projects have already begun being funded and implemented.
- The 2035 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) – This plan allocated a large portion of funding to transit and bicycle/pedestrian projects.
- The next phase of mobility projects is being developed based on a master planned process.
- The focus for the Complete Streets Master Plan is on identifying deficiencies/gaps and propose quality projects that encourage the use of these type of facilities and improve the comfort and safety of non-motorized users
- Complete Streets benefits include: Safety, Health & Happiness, Equity, Sustainability, Economics, and Sense of Community.
- The public outreach will occur in the Summer/Fall 2017.

- A lane elimination project coordination process is being developed as part of the Master Plan.
- Identify what are the major trip generators and incorporate the data into a heat map.
- Regular review of maintenance plans at a local level.
- The MPO's intent with this Master Plan is to have the plan adopted and implemented. It is important to collaborate with local partners to identify grant opportunities and work together to fund the projects in the priority order determined by the plan.

Priority Pyramid

During the kickoff meeting, PAC members participated in a prioritization pyramid exercise during which various categories of ways to prioritize projects were ranked. The top three concepts/themes of prioritization ranked by PAC members in attendance are as follows.

1. Safety – Increases safety for all users
2. Social Equity – Allows for or enhances equal opportunities for all users
3. Added Mobility Options – Includes multiple mode types

Next Steps

- Continue interagency coordination through PAC.
- Prepare the transportation analysis.
- Kick off the public outreach.
- Identify needs and projects.
- The next PAC meeting will discuss the transportation demand analysis and initial gaps analysis.

Action Items

- Recommend having PAC meetings in alternating months as CSAC meetings. PAC meetings will be the fourth Monday of the alternate month.
