FOOTNOTES:

The eight Transit Corridors were ranked in the following order: 1) US1, 2) Oakland Park Blvd, 3) State Road 7, 4) Broward Blvd, 5) Hollywood/Pines Blvds, 6) Sunrise Blvd, 7) University Dr, 8) Dixie Hwy.

Mobility hubs and top-ranked bicycle and pedestrian facilities adjacent to these eight corridors are clustered in this listing. Those at the intersections of two primary transit corridors are listed under the top-ranking corridor only.

1 This unfunded priority is also listed in the Port Everglades Unfunded Project List.

2 Various sidewalk projects are addressed through an annual funding "set-aside" of \$750,000.

* Projects 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17 are based on Broward County Transportation Department's Transit Development Plan (TDP) priorities.
