THE POSITION

The Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has an exciting opportunity for a talented professional to join the Communications and Outreach team as a Public Outreach Officer. The Communications and Outreach Team is responsible for coordinating the development and implementation of public engagement strategies, plans, and campaigns to meet the MPO's local, state, and federal requirements, goals and objectives.

Other duties include, but not limited to:

- Support the development and periodic updates to the Public Participation Plan, consistent with all state and federal requirements;
- Manage the MPO's website, ensuring content is up-to-date and the website functions are operating smoothly.
- Manage all aspects of the agency's social media platforms;
- Develop public relations and informational materials for external audiences to establish and maintain public awareness of, and engagement with, MPO activities including news releases, fact sheets, speeches, presentations, surveys, flyers, social media content, and videos;
- Coordinate, plan, and execute public engagement events for a variety of audiences, including community stakeholders, government agencies, and the media; and
- Establish, maintain, and grow relationships with members of the public, community representatives, government agencies, public interest groups, and civic organizations.
