## **Transportation Surtax Overview**

June 2018: Broward County Commission enacted the Transportation Surtax Ordinance



**November 2018:** County voters approved one cent sales surtax which took effect on January 1, 2019



March 2019: 1<sup>st</sup> distribution of surtax revenues received by the County from the Dept. of Revenue (pennyfortransportation.com)






## **Example Assessment of "Shovel Readiness"**
