


BUNDLE F

Bundle Areas exhibit a high demand for biking and walking and a high concentration of vulnerable populations.



DESCRIPTION

Bundle F is located in the City of Sunrise. The future land use is primarily residential with a few commerce, community and recreation and open space areas. There are a handful of community features such as parks, schools, a library and Sunrise City Hall which attracts users to this area. The Broward MPO Bicycle & Pedestrian Safety Action Plan identifies the area at University Drive and Oakland Park Boulevard as a crash hot spot which represents a statistically significant concentration of crashes. The crash hot spot correlate with the high transit ridership areas; the areas with the highest land use intensity and mix; and the highest propensities for walking, bicycling, and riding transit. Seven proposed projects were identified along with the C-13 Canal Trail for Bundle F.
