



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETINGS FOR PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE BROWARD MPO COMMITMENT 2045 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN (MTP)

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (Broward MPO) will hold public meetings, providing the public with three opportunities to make verbal comments on proposed amendments to the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan:

- Citizens' Advisory Committee on Wednesday, January 25, 2023 at 6:00 p.m.
- Broward MPO Board on Thursday, February 9, 2023 at 9:30 a.m.

## Amendment to the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) to include the following:

- Amend Cost and Timeframe in the MTP I-95 @ Davie Blvd Project (Roadway Reference ID #9)
  - Cost: <u>from</u> "2025: \$3,637,000; 2026-2030: \$18,013,000" <u>to</u> "2025: \$0; 2026-2030: \$21,650,000".
- Amend Description and Cost in the MTP I-95 @ Griffin Road Project (Roadway Reference ID #10)
  - Description: <u>from</u> "I-95 @ Griffin Road (Modify Interchange)" <u>to</u> "I-95 from Miami-Dade/Broward Co. Line to North of Griffin Road (Interchange Justification/Modification)".
  - Cost: <u>from</u> "2025: \$14,880,000; 2026-2030: \$36,772,000" <u>to</u> "2025: \$0; 2026-2030: \$50,040,000".

- Amend Cost and Timeframe in the MTP SR-7 @ Commercial Blvd Project (Roadway Reference ID #50)
  - Cost: <u>from</u> "2031-2035: \$499,411,200" <u>to</u> "2025: \$ 600,000; 2031-2035: \$498,499,200".
- Amend the MTP to <u>add</u> project to the Cost Feasible Plan Museum of Discovery and Science Transportation Education Exhibit (Roadway Reference ID #136)
  - Description: "Develop an interactive public engagement transportation exhibit highlighting resiliency and how to address the impacts of climate change on Broward's transportation system"
  - **Cost:** "2025: \$1,500,000"
- Amend the MTP to <u>add</u> project to the Illustrative Plan Plantation Midtown Bridge Project (Roadway Reference ID #137)
  - Description: "New bridge connection over SFWMD New River Canal from SW 17<sup>th</sup> Street to SR-84"
  - **Cost:** "2025: \$1,191,898"
- Amend the MTP to <u>add</u> project to the Illustrative Plan Broward Commuter Rail South (Transit Reference ID #7)
  - Description: "Commuter rail service on FEC rail corridor from Broward Health Center between 15<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> Streets in Fort Lauderdale to Brightline/Commuter Rail Station in Aventura"
  - **Cost:** "2025: \$23,650,000"
  - Note: This project replaces the "Tri-Rail Coastal Link (TRCL) Transit Reference ID #7" project included as an unfunded need in the 2045 Transit Plan
