- Recommendations:**
- Dedicated left turn signal phasing from NW 6th St
 - Pedestrian streetlights
 - Improved pedestrian signals
 - Restripe existing crosswalks with high-visibility pavement markings
 - ADA compliant curb ramps and detectable warnings

- Sidewalk Recommendation:**
- Trim / remove landscaping that is blocking access of full sidewalk

Westport

- Recommendations:**
- Reconfigure intersection median to prohibit Left-turns out of NW 4th Ct (continue to permit left-turn in, right-turn in, and right-turn out)
 - Extend sidewalks on NW 4th Ct east to Nob Hill Rd
 - Crosswalk over NW 4th Court
 - Crosswalk over Nob Hill Rd, with RRFBs and Pedestrian Refuge
 - Pedestrian streetlights at Nob Hill Road






Signalized Mid-block Crosswalk with pedestrian-refuge would provide access to the sidewalk on the east side of Nob Hill Rd

Median extensions on Nob Hill Road would prohibit Left-turns from NW 4th Court



Cleary Blvd: Hiatus Road to Nob Hill Road

- Recommendations:**
- Pedestrian Bridge over Hiatus Rd Canal • Wayfinding / Signage
 - Pedestrian streetlights • Pedestrian signal improvements
 - Restripe existing crosswalk to high-visibility markings
 - New crosswalks over Hiatus Rd (with pedestrian refuge)
 - Remove U-Turn Lane / convert into raised median with pedestrian refuge
 - Left-turn safety improvements (southbound to eastbound)
 - Pedestrian-Only Entrance to Sunset Park

- Recommendations:**
- Pedestrian streetlights
 - Pedestrian signal improvements
 - Widen southern crosswalk to width of new shared use path



- Recommendations:**
- New Shared Use Path abutting Sunset Park
 - Pedestrian-Only Park Entrances
 - Raised Crosswalks at parking lots entrances
 - Raised Crosswalks over Cleary Bl leading to pedestrian-only park entrances
 - Convert existing crosswalk at eastern park entrance to Raised Crosswalk

- Reconfigure existing sidewalk in Cleary Bl's southern right-of-way to Shared Use Path (from Sunset Park Entrance to University Dr)












Lane Reduction from Plantation Promenade to Shoppes at Cleary

Existing Conditions: Typical Section between Central Park PL and Central Park Dr



Recommended Improvements

New 6 ft wide bike "Protected" bike path

Remaining Drive Lane Reduced to 11 ft wide, with 4 ft shoulder

Sidewalks widened to 10 ft

Cleary Blvd: Pine Island Road to University Drive

Recommendations:

- Pedestrian streetlights
- Wayfinding / Signage
- Pedestrian signal Improvements
- Restripe existing crosswalks to high-visibility markings
- Eliminate Right-Turn only lane on Cleary Blvd (east bound to south bound) and convert to Shared Use Path
- Widen southern crosswalk to width of new shared use path

Roadway reconfiguration from west of Lauderdale West Dr to St Tropez entrance = Lane Elimination with Shared Use Path


