Purpose of Workshop. As South Florida continues to grow and urbanize, the potential for conflicts between goods movement and smart growth urban planning is rising. The motor carrier industry has adopted 53-foot trailers and tandem trailers as the standard for overthe-road freight transport, while urban neighborhoods are being designed with priority placed on pedestrian and bicyclist safety and enjoyment. As a result, the standard over-the-road freight vehicle is not conducive to performing last-mile distribution and delivery in a growing number of communities in the region. This leads planners and other stakeholders to consider how to accommodate communities' needs for goods and services while maintaining the principles of smart growth and complete streets. Recent publications, such as the National Cooperative Highway Research Program Report 844 and National Cooperative Freight Research Program Report 33 identify the key issues, common strategies, and the considerations and tradeoffs that come with implementation.

The purpose of this workshop is:

- Bring practitioners from diverse backgrounds/experiences together
- Discuss key issues, conflicts, trends, and best practices nationally and in South Florida
- Discuss potential strategies to consider and/or advance in South Florida

The workshop will contain a mix of instructor-led discussion and small-group exercises aimed at raising awareness of key issues, evaluating case studies, and discussing potential solutions applicable in South Florida.

Who Should Attend. Local municipality and county staff engaged in land use planning and zoning, transportation planning and engineering, complete streets, urban design, economic development, and access management as well as key industry associations involved in promoting a competitive business environment.
