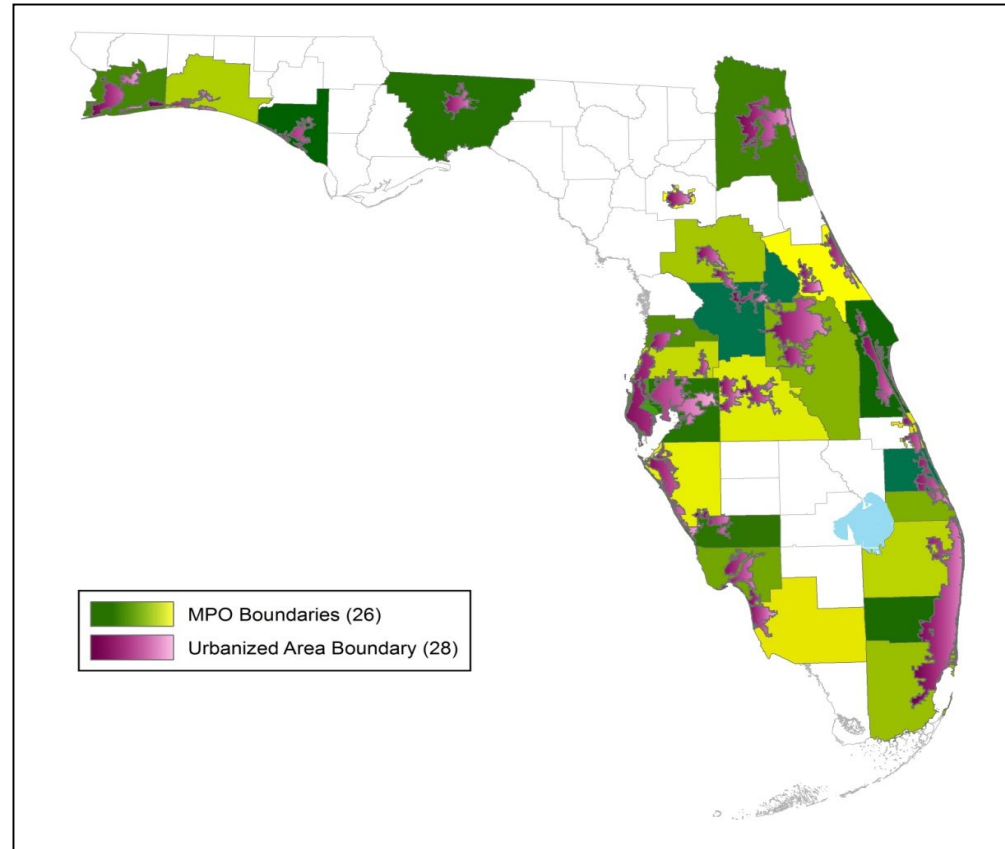
The MPO is **funding** and **planning** the future of Broward's transportation network.

Types of Urban Planners

- **Community planners** build consensus in the community on how it should grow, and how each piece of land around a city should be used.
- **Environmental planners** make sure that important natural features of a community are protected. This includes protecting lakes, rivers, and wetlands from pollution.
- **Transportation planners** plan a city's transportation system: roads and highways, railroads, bike paths, and sidewalks.

Urbanized Areas & Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Areas

Areas with **50,000+** population, must have or be a part of at least one MPO

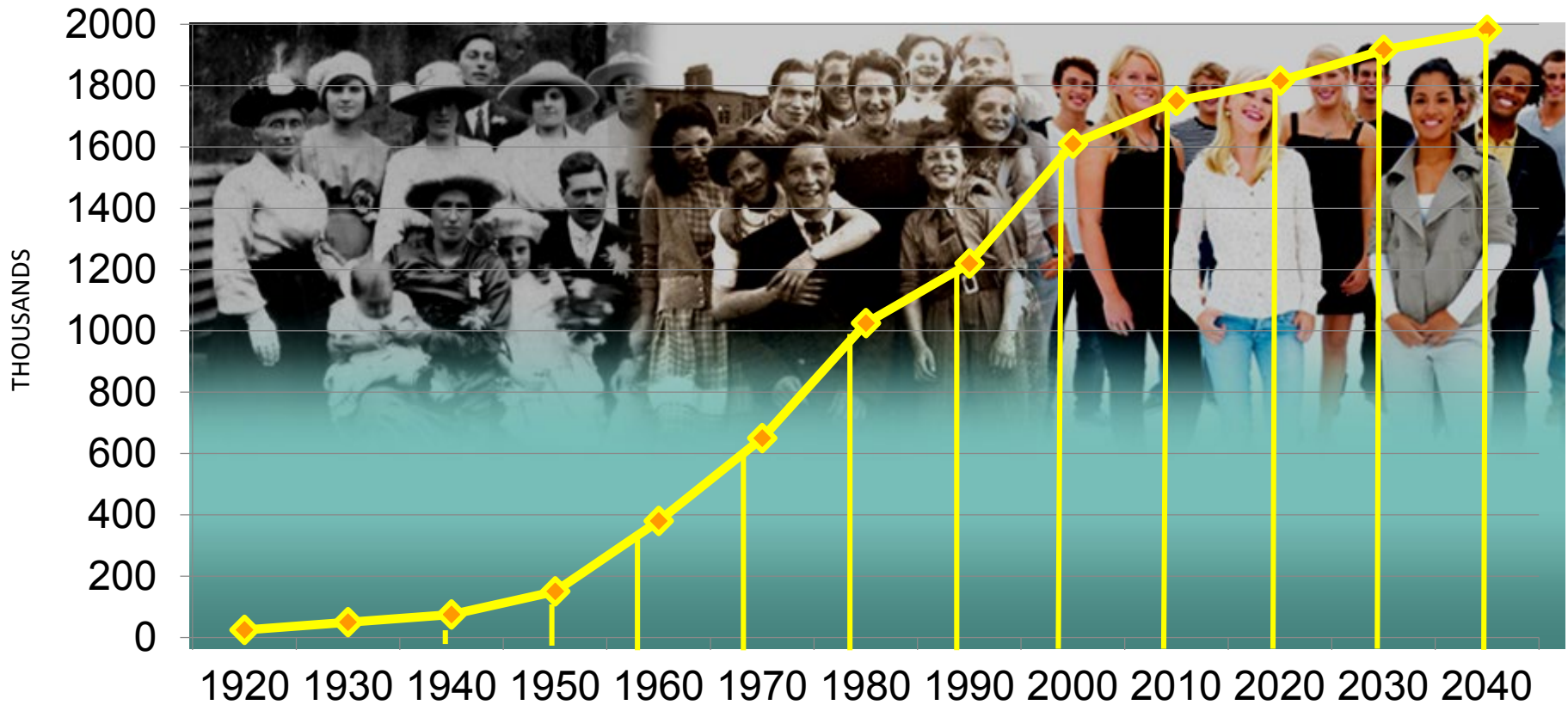

Population: How Have We Grown!

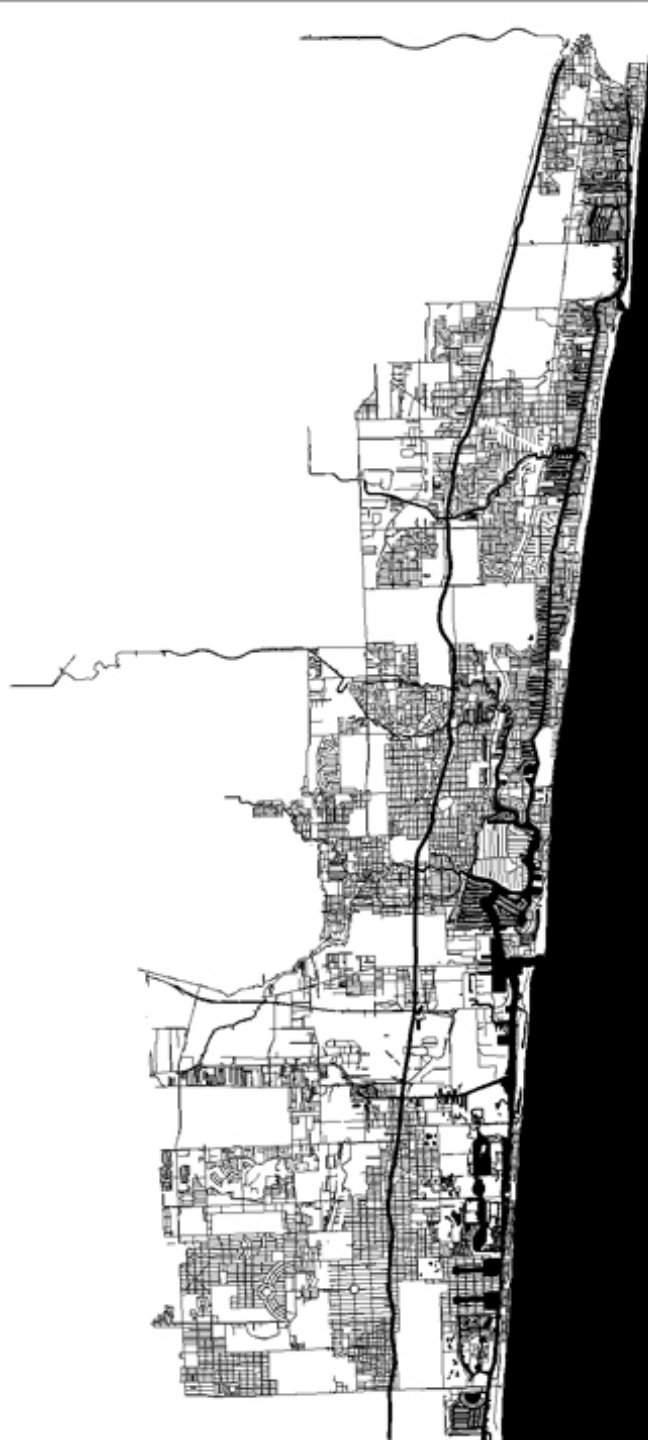

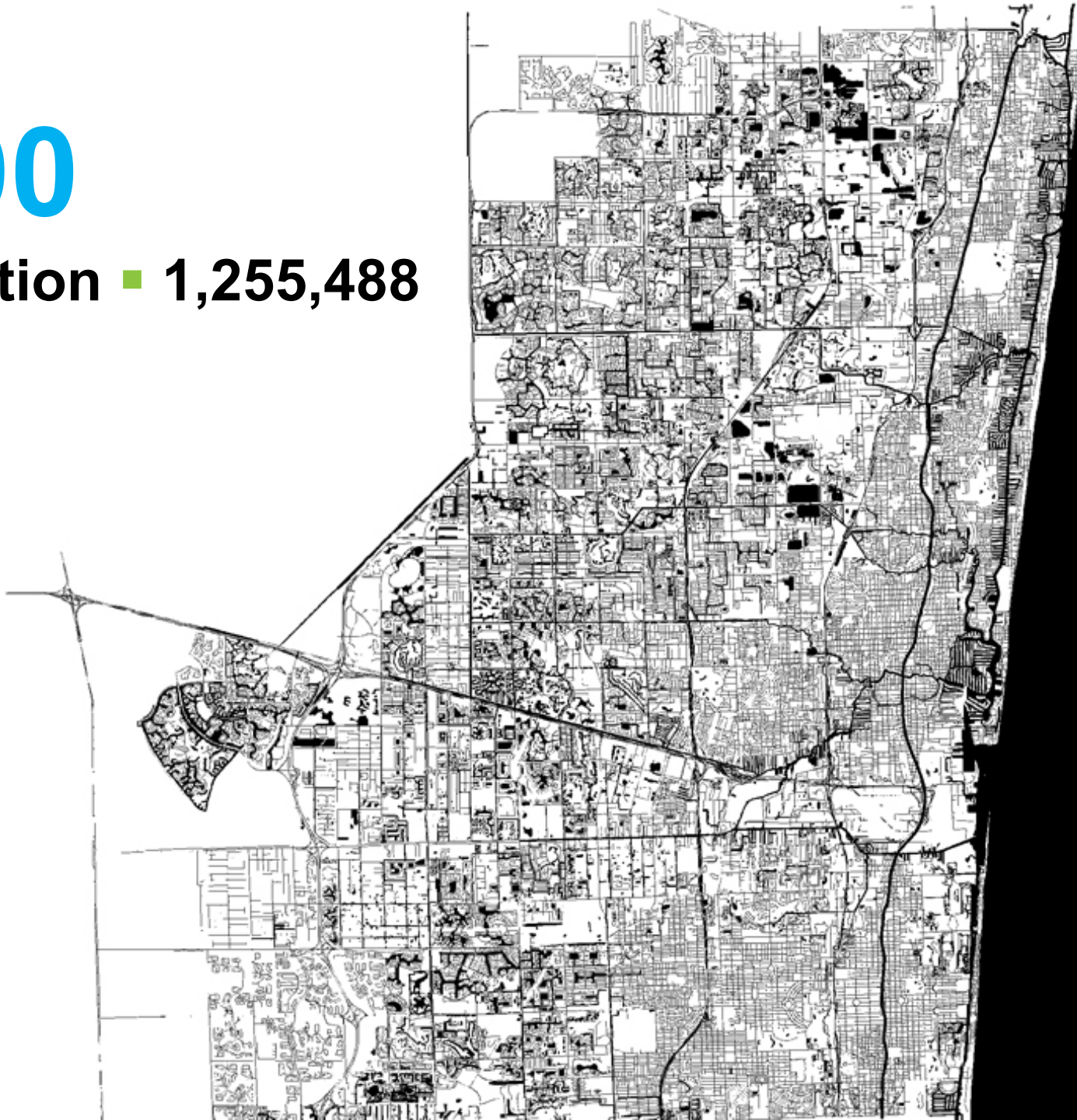

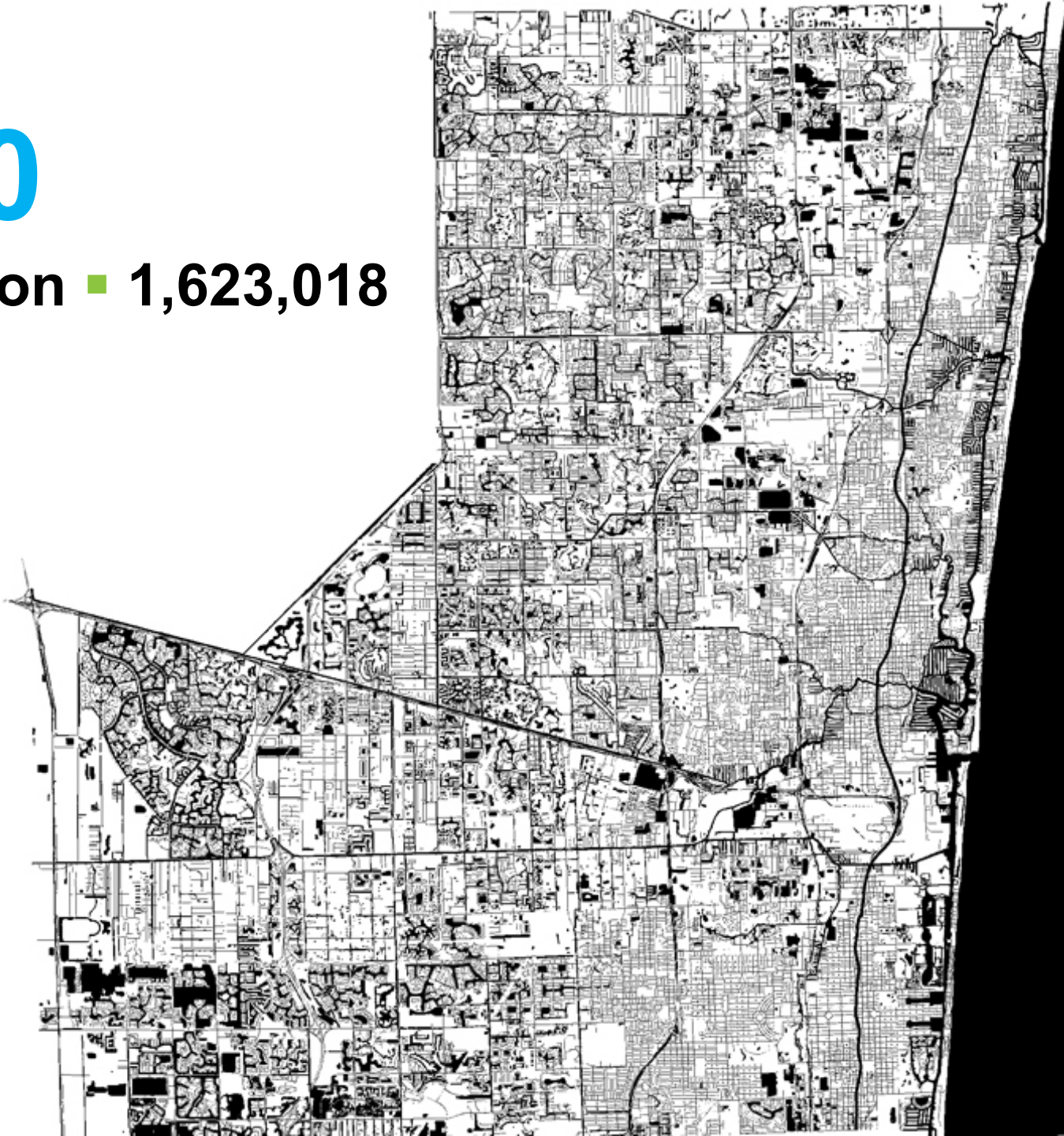

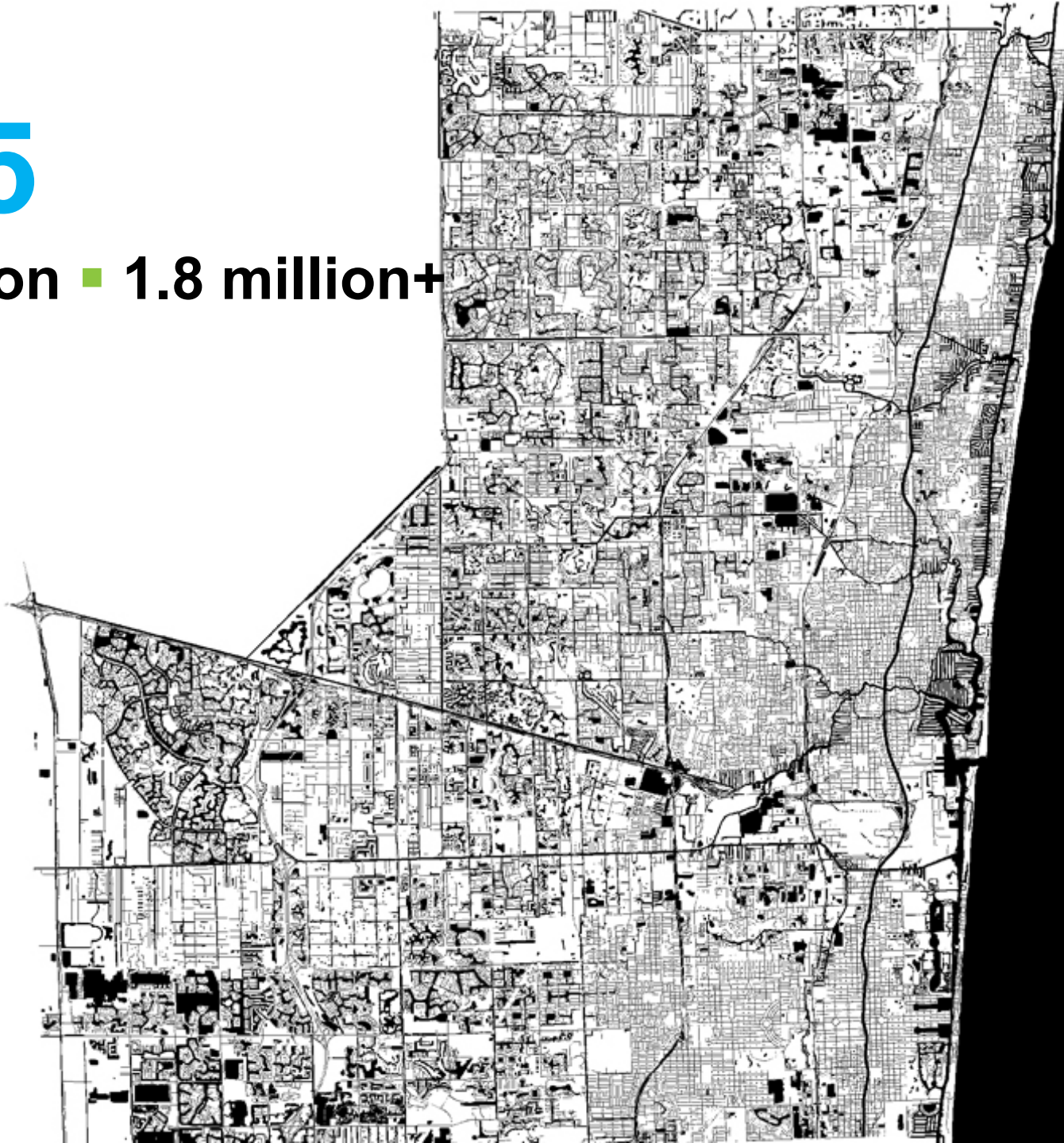

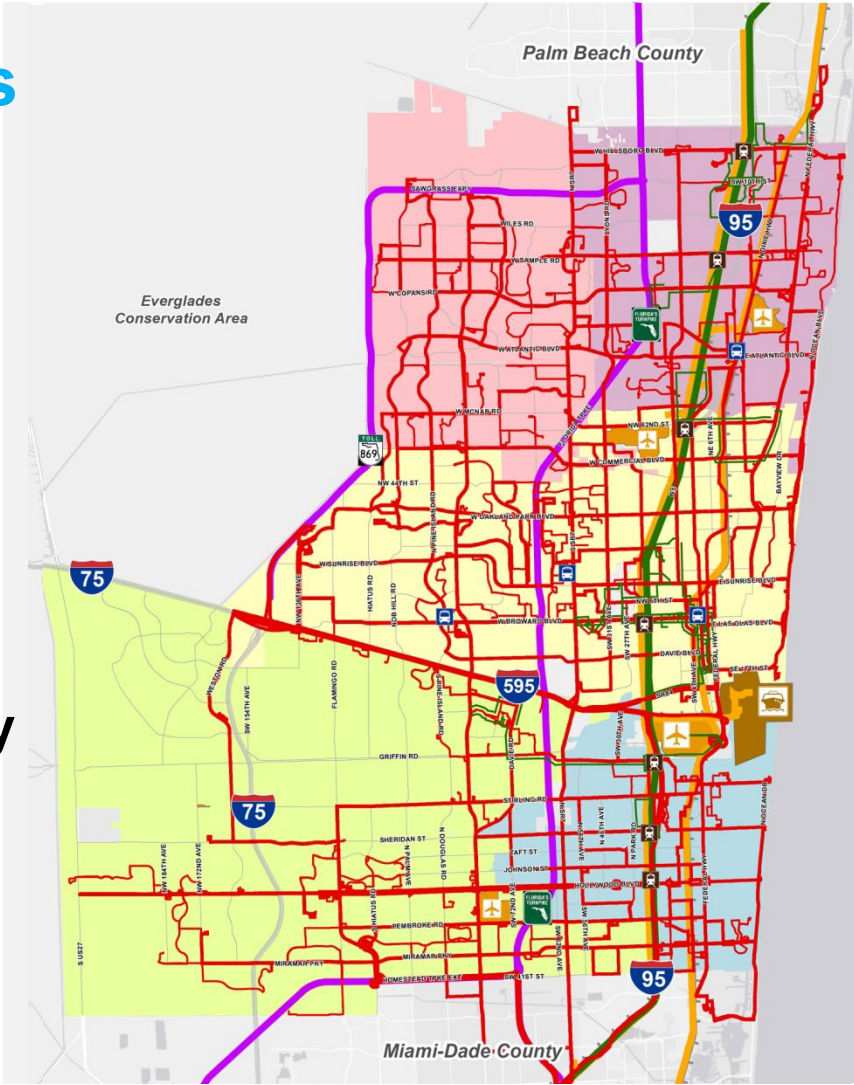
