In 2014, the Broward MPO led the FHWA-funded climate change vulnerability and adaptation pilot project for the four-county South Florida region. In 2015, the MPO funded a Phase II study that focused on Broward roadways.



The Broward MPO identified the impacts to roadways as sea level rise, storm surge, and precipitation-based.



The Broward MPO has hosted training for the following groups: Federal Transportation Administration (FTA), Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), University of Florida and Broward County.



The MPO incorporated study findings into transportation decision making throughout the 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) process.
