Pursuant to Part IV – Chapter 5: Statewide and Local Transportation Improvement Programs (STIP and TIP) of the Work Program Instructions, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) requests your processing and approval of the attached modification to the FY 2023/24 – 2027/28 Transportation Improvement Program.

This modification is for funds that are being added that do not exceed the 20% AND \$2M threshold which does not meet the criteria for a formal TIP/STIP Amendment and needs to be reflected in the TIP.

The Town of Davie appreciates and values its relationship with the Broward MPO. We are seeking Broward MPO's assistance and support in modifying one of our federal projects, FM Project #443950-1: Orange Drive from SW 92nd Avenue to SW 62nd Avenue. Specifically, the Town is looking to adjust the project limits as the sidewalk network conditions along the Orange Drive corridor will be positively impacted by redevelopment opportunities that were not contemplated when the CSLIP Application was originally submitted. These include:

- Surtax funding approved for design and construction of the DAVI-16
 Orange Drive Corridor Enhancement Project between the Florida Turnpike to Davie Road.
- The Town's Frontier Development Agreement for the properties located on Orange Drive between the Davie Road and SW 65 Way.
- The Town's decision to move forward with the construction of a new Town Hall on Orange Drive west of SW 65 Way.
- The Site Plan approval for the redevelopment of a new gas station at the northeast corner of University Drive and Orange Drive.

These projects will implement the remaining sidewalk network links between SW 62nd Avenue and SW 67th Avenue and ensure federal dollars are not wasted. Therefore, the new project limits will begin at SW 67th Avenue and extend westward to SW 92nd Avenue. I have provided a revised Location Map for additional clarification.

The Town finds value in the implementation of this CSLIP Project and requests the MPO's continued support towards that end.
