


The Metropolitan Transportation Plan
Your Long Range Transportation Plan contains a prioritized list of cost-feasible transportation needs in Broward County for the next 20+ years. **Updated every five (5) years; federally required.**



The Multimodal Priorities List
Your MMPL prioritizes "program ready" projects from the MTP into your Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). **Updated annually.**



The Transportation Improvement Program
Your TIP is a comprehensive list of funded transportation projects spanning the next five (5) years. It must inform the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). **Updated annually; federally required.**



The Unified Planning Work Program
Your UPWP specifies the work to be completed by the Broward MPO and its partners. It contains budget details for these efforts. **Updated every two (2) years; federally required.**



The Strategic Business Plan
Your SBP represents the MPO Board's Mission, Vision, and Values for the future of the organization. **Updated every two (2) years.**



The Public Participation Plan
Your PPP provides guidelines for achieving optimum public participation. **Updated every four (4) years; federally required.**

WHAT WE ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- Ensure that the Metropolitan Transportation Planning Process is "**continuous, comprehensive, and cooperative**," between the State and local communities;
- Coordinate with our partners across jurisdictional boundaries for **populations greater than 50,000**; and
- Develop transportation **plans and policies** that ensure federal funds from taxes **support local priorities**; and
- **Secure funding** for improvements to our transportation infrastructure.
