TRAC (Transportation and Civil Engineering) is a hands-on, educational outreach program of the American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO). The TRAC program is designed for integration into science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM). State Departments of Transportation provide the program free of charge to middle and high schools in their state. The Broward MPO has worked with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to bring this training to Florida. We hope to make this an annual training event.

Vision: To deliver educational outreach programs that connect students to the world of transportation while enhancing math, science, and technology skills.
